**Children Welcome at St. Luke!**

Each Sunday children are invited to come to the front of the sanctuary for a Children's Message or to attend Children's Church. Children's Church is designed for children age 4 through 3rd grade and is available during the 8:00 AM or 10:30 AM worship service each Sunday. Children are dismissed after the Gospel reading and return to the worship service just before Holy Communion. Children 3 and under are invited to go to the "Little Critter Pond" room during this time. A Children's Sermon is offered at the opposite service and children (and parents) are invited to come forward for this special message prior to the sermon. Children are always welcome to remain in the pew with their parents. Children attending Children's Church should meet on the large red square of carpet in the narthex (just as you enter the Fellowship Café) at the time children are dismissed for Children's Church. Older children and teens who would like to assist with Children's Church must now sign-up on the bulletin board outside Cynthia Cronrath's office (back by the Activity Rooms). Thank you.

**The Sacrament of Holy Communion**

All who are here at worship today are invited to receive Holy Communion. For those who prefer, the prefilled glasses contain non-fermented grape juice. - In the event of a "Pastoral Emergency", dial 784-5035 and press "0" when prompted to do so. This will connect you with the person "on call".

Remember, if the visit is at a medical facility, please ensure you indicate the name of the facility and the room number.

**Policy for Names Being Added to the Prayer List  
(Approved by Congregation Council October 8, 2007)**

To ensure the privacy of information the Congregation Council of St. Luke Lutheran Church, Bloomsburg, PA provides the following guidelines for adding a person's name to the prayer list. St. Luke Church highly encourages a community in prayer for the needs of members, friends and families. However, the church also recognizes the need to protect personal and private information. In order to maintain the balance between the benefit of prayer and personal privacy the Congregation Council has established the following:

- A person can request that their name be added to the prayer list and it will be added.
- If a person requests another person's name be added to the prayer list, that person must have the permission of the person prior to the name being added.
- The prayer list will include the person's first name and last initial (full last name may be included with the permission of the person being added to the prayer list).
- The reason for being on the prayer list will be listed as health concerns, healing, general concerns, recovery, grieving, etc. Specific information as to the exact medical issues will not be listed.

A person can be added to the prayer list by talking to Ministries Coordinator (Mike McCay) or calling the Church Office. A name will stay on the list for a minimum of three weeks. It may be removed sooner if requested. As long as an update is
